

Here is how the Bluetooth Driver runs USB Adapter in the Windows XP SP2.

1. After the installation of the driver, plug the USB adapter into PC. Now, the USB Adapter is not yet activated.( The red color of the Bluetooth Icon indicates that the Bluetooth device is not yet activated.)




2. Choose Generic Bluetooth Radio in Bluetooth




# 3. Choose **Update Driver** in **Driver** icon.




# 4. Choose <u>Install from a list or specific location</u>

(Advanced) and click Next.




5. Choose <u>Don't search</u>. I will choose the driver to <u>install</u> and click <u>Next</u>.




## 6. Choose CSR USB Bluetooth Device and click
